One person's entrepreneurial spirit has grown Middleburg Heights, Ohio, USAbased Codonics, Inc. from a solo start to an international company with a wellestablished brand in the global medical field. Today, Codonics has nearly 200 employees, more than 30,000 product installations, and is represented in over 80 countries. Grown from humble beginnings, Codonics is now a multimillion dollar international business that provides the medical industry with some of the most advanced medical imaging products in the world. Codonics full product line is exported to 120 countries, with over 70% of sales accounted for through growth in exports.

Founded in 1982, Codonics initially started as a computer graphics manufacturer. Interest in medical imaging quickly evolved to devices and communication software as preferred hardcopy solutions for diagnostic medical imaging systems. By 1983, Codonics moved to their first office space in Middleburg Heights, Ohio. Working with and leveraging the sales presence of OEM medical system manufacturers, the company sales began to soar and Codonics quickly outgrew the space. Today the facility now spans 100,000 square feet and is home to Codonics production, warehousing, engineering R&D, sales, service, marketing, and administrative offices.

The catalyst of the company's growth was the introduction of a new product

line in November 1999 at the world's largest medical assembly, the Radiological Society of North America trade show in. Codonics unveiled the Horizon® Multimedia Medical Imager, the world's first medical imager to combine film, color, and grayscale technologies in a desktopsize printing device. The product competes head-to-head with those offered by major global film manufacturers in the medical imaging industry.

Since 1999, the company has continued to experience amazing growth, and has launched several innovative product lines including the Virtua Medical Disc Publisher, the Integrity Medical Disc Importer, and the Infinity Medical Image Server. All Codonics products are export-ready and compliant with international electrical and medical regulatory requirements.

Most recently, the company has licensed technology from Massachusetts General Hospital, expanding Codonics products into the operating room. Based upon the SmartLabels technology, Codonics 500i Safe Label System improves patient safety anywhere syringes are prepared. User's simply scan a drug vial and the system instantly checks the hospital's formulary to ensure the drug is allowed to be used. The process significantly simplifies the documentation process.
